






Action Thursday 27.7. 4pm - 6pm

The Katanpää fort island is located along the strait of Ströömi on the Lypyrtti island in Kustavi, which is part of the Bothnian Sea National Park. The island's unique nature, historic buildings and sheltered port make it an excellent spot for a day trip.

The fort was built in the 1910s during the reign of Tsar Nicholas II. In the 1930s, there was also an auxiliary prison operating at the fort. The fort structures and buildings, including the cobblestone street and the wooden water tower, are protected under the Antiquities Act.

Exhibition CAPTAINS - Multitalented at Sea and on Land at Wahlberg Museum House main floor



The main exhibition of Wahlberg Museum House in the year 2023. The exhibition "Captains -

Multitalented at Sea and on Land" tells the stories of eight Uusikaupunki captains, their lives, careers, and families.

Uusikaupunki has always been a maritime city, and its residents have made their living from seafaring. Even in the 19th century, the most common occupations in the city were related to maritime professions. While not diminishing the importance of the rest of the

crew, the captains of the ships and their actions have left the most information for future generations. However, sea captains were not just captains, and their work was not solely about leading the crew. It is no wonder, then, that many captains, especially after retiring from their captaincy, engaged in various tasks related to merchant shipping.

In addition to their other roles, captains were usually husbands and fathers. When at sea, they had to spend long periods away from their families, creating a constant sense of longing and concern for both sides. The profession of being a captain posed challenges to the lives of the entire family but often provided a comfortable livelihood and good connections abroad.



Naval Pilot Museum



Cultural History Walk-brochure

The Tourist Office provides a brochure on the Cultural History Walk, which allows you to explore on your own the history and sights of the city. The cultural walk is a four-kilometer-long historic walking trail along which most of the downtown tourist attractions are located. The brochure shows a map and a short description of 33 different sights.

Paper maps are available at Tourist office/Service Point Passari.

Go outside and explore Uusikaupunki - Find the hidden statues!

Hidden Play is a series of small bronze sculptures hidden in the terrain that can be searched for using a digital or printed map. Each route comes with a mobile game that helps you look at the environment from different angles and learn new things. The search is free of charge for the participants. Hidden Play is a combination of community art and treasure hunting games (eg geocaching). Young people have made statues at workshops, brainstormed, and planned a route.



The route is suitable for everyone: residents, school classes, seniors, work groups, travelers, etc. The route runs on both sides of the bay and is about 4-5 km long. You can search for hidden play sculptures at: https://piiloleikki.fi/

Hiunjärvi nature trail

Hiunjärvi is a lake located just north of the Uusikaupunki town centre.

Despite its proximity to the centre, the area has remained relatively sparsely populated. The lake is around 12 hectares, and around a third of its

surface area is covered by thick vegetation. Hiunjärvi is a popular spot for birdwatching. There is also a nature trail around the lake. Along the trail you can find a lean-to and a bird watching tower. You can access the trail near the pedestrian underpass by the Saarnisto school or at the end of **Puolukkatie** or **Otavakuja**. The distance from the underpass to the lean-to is about 1 km. The longest route around

the trail from the underpass is 3.8 km, and a shorter one is 3.2 km. The distance from the Juolukkatie entrance to the leanto is 0.7 km. The longest route around the trail from Puolukkatie is 3.6 km, and a shorter one is 1.4 km. From Otavakuja, the shortest route to the lean-to is 1.4 km. The trail is marked using orange diamond symbols as well as by maps located at the starting points and at crossroads.



Kasarminlahti accessible nature trail and birdwatching point



Kasarminlahdentie 8, Uusikaupunki (entrance to accessible trail), with larger parking area.

Accessible birdwatching point and nature trail offer the opportunity to enjoy the forest and get near the water safely. The Kasarminlahti area has a lot of different bird species, and many migratory birds also stop there. Kasarminlahti is located less than two kilometres from the market square. Services on the accessible section: birdwatching platform, nature trail, accessible composting outhouse, and benches. In addition to the accessible trail to the

birdwatching platform, there is a more demanding trail (not accessible) to the Kasarminlahti lean-to and the Vionpuhti campfire spot. The trail is hilly and part of it is on rocky terrain.

Pamprinniemi nature trail

The Pamprinniemi nature trail is located in Ketteli in Pyhämaa on church-owned land. The trail is about 4 kilometres long. The area is a significant nature and bird conservation area, as it has been maintained in its natural state. It is part of the European Natura 2000 network. Along the trail, you can experience many kinds of natural surroundings from the seaside to old spruce forests and patches of

fern. The church has also erected some Bible-themed story boards around the trail. There is a large wooden cross at the tip of the peninsula where the church usually holds an opening ceremony for the trail in early June. The road leading to the trail, Hauintie, is a private road. The trail is open yearround, weather conditions permitting.



Lean-tos

The City of Uusikaupunki has built three lean-tos in different parts of the town. They can be found in **Hiu, Kasarminlahti, and Oinassaari**. Vakka-Suomen Latu outdoor association has also built a campfire spot in Vionpuhti, near Kasarminlahti.

Sauna at Metsälehto

Haimiontie 365, Uusikaupunki

Summer swimming on Tuesdays. The sauna is located on the shore of a freshwater pool in Haimio. The sauna is spacious and gives good baths! The walkway is partially protected with melting mats and mats to prevent slippage. You should bring a small towel under your feet in the changing room, swimming slippers or socks and a beanie or other headgear. In the sauna, it is important to drink fluids, so also bring something to drink.



There is a barbecue area on the beach, and there is a barbecue hut in the yard. Summer swimming evenings are open to everyone.

Sauna fees in the summer season: €3/person and €1/children under 12 years old.

The Tourist Information Office

Provides advice and service on all matters related to Uusikaupunki travel: places to visit, events, brochures, maps, guide distribution, program packages for groups, bicycle rental (also e-bikes), fishing permits for Uusikaupunki town.

The office sells Uusikaupunki -themed postcards, books etc, Crusell Week products, etc. Guests have free access to internet. Tickets: Crusell Week, summer theatre Lentävä Lokki

The Citizen's service Passari is in the same building as the tourist office. Tourist Information Office is open Mon - Fri 9am - 4.30pm, in July also open on Saturdays 10am – 3pm.
