Museums and more



The Museum of Uusikaupunki

Ylinenkatu 11

Summer opening hours: Mon–Fri from 10 am to 5 pm and Sat–Sun from 12 pm to 3 pm

A handsome bourgeois house, previously owned by a tobacco factory owner, provides insight into life in the 19th century. Maritime section upstairs. Guided tours on summer Thursdays at 2pm. The main exhibition of 2018 showcases the favourite pastimes of local youth from different decades. Come and reminisce about the favourite hangouts and activities of youngsters from the 1960s as well as the 1990s

Children are also taken into account. They can play detectives in the museum and do different tasks related to the exhibition. During the summer, a separate play area for children will be opened in the outbuilding.

Tickets: Adults EUR 5 (price includes Naval Pilot Museum and Sailor's Home Museum), free admission for people under the age of 18.

Jun-Aug: Open daily 10am-6pm

There are more than 100 vehicles in three large exhibition halls, including the largest Saab collection in the world, old motorbikes and mopeds as well as two airplanes and a garage museum.

Pilvilinna is a colourful and amusingly unique art house. Both the outside and the inside of the house are filled with paintings and exhibitions by artist Raija Nokkala, and the walls are filled with the cloud-themed poems of Ulla Kamppinen. This year Pilvilinna's garden is filled with hundreds of roses, and the coffee terrace has been extended.

Pakkahuone Guest harbour

Open Tue – Sun from 10 am to 5 pm

Miniature of the barque Warma located in the exhibition space in VaSo's brick tower at Pakkahuone guest harbour. Warma was the last wooden sailing ship that was built in Uusikaupunki. The scale model is 7.5 m in length, 2m in width and 4.3 m in height.

This summer also photography exhibition about Windjammer Herzogin Cecilie. She sailed under German, French and Finnish flags and now there has been new findings about the sailors.

The Uusikaupunki and Pyhämaa churches are open from June 5 to August 13 Mon-Sat 11am-5pm and Sun 12pm-4pm

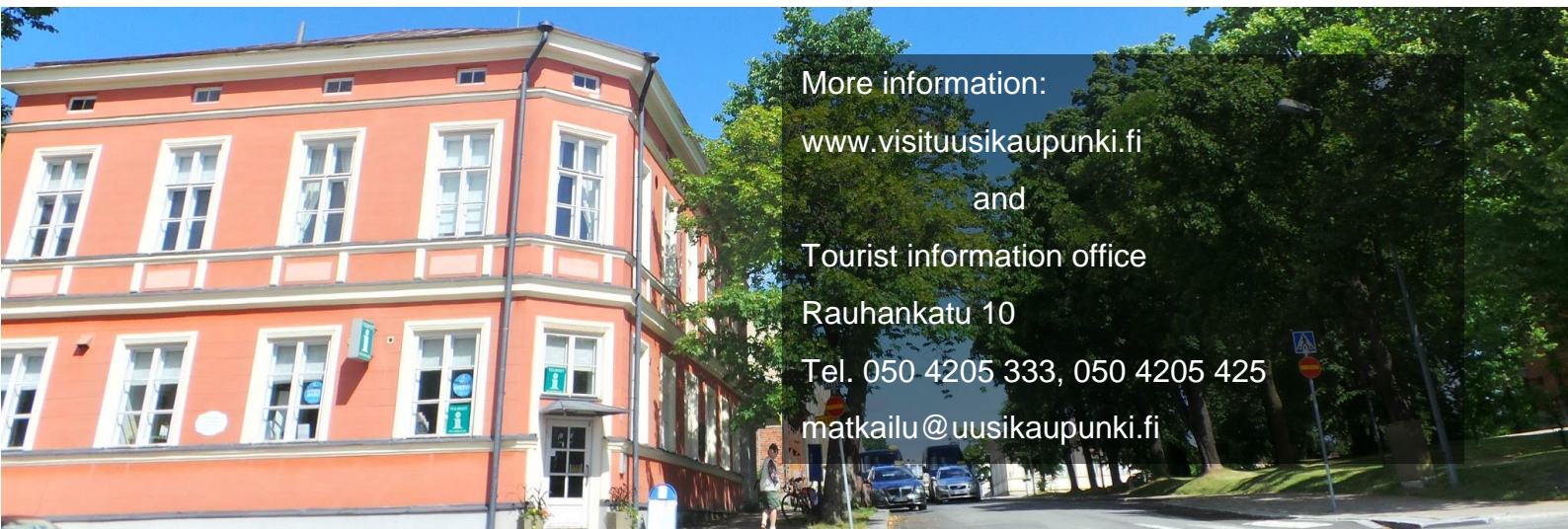
The Kalanti and Lokalanti churches from June 26 to August 6 Mon-Sat 11am-5pm and Sun 12pm-4pm.
