A pump track is a type of off-road terrain for cycle sport consisting of a circuit of banked turns and features designed to be ridden completely by riders "pumping" - creating momentum by up and down body movements. They are relatively simple and cater to a wide variety of rider skill levels. You can take part with a BMX-bike, skateboard, longboard, push scooter, rollerskates, wheelchair or by jogging.

The Museum of Uusikaupunki

Ylienkatu 11

Summer opening hours: Mon–Fri from 10 am to 5 pm and Sat–Sun from 12 pm to 3 pm

A handsome bourgeois house, previously owned by a tobacco factory owner, provides insight into life in the 19th century. Maritime section upstairs. Guided tours on summer Thursdays at 2pm. The main exhibition of 2018 showcases the favourite pastimes of local youth from different decades. Come and reminisce about the favourite hangouts and activities of youngsters from the 1960s as well as the 1990s

Children are also taken into account. They can play detectives in the museum and do different tasks related to the exhibition. During the summer, a separate play area for children will be opened in the outbuilding.

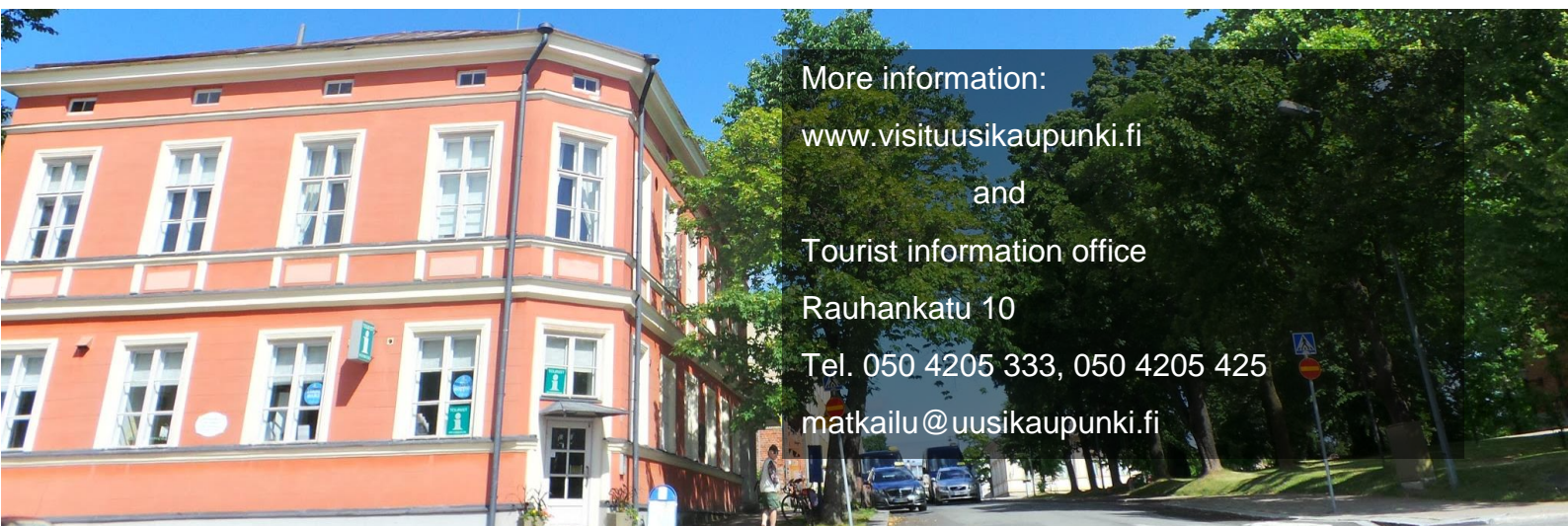
The Uusikaupunki and Pyhämaa churches are open from June 5 to August 13 Mon-Sat 11am-5pm and Sun 12pm-4pm
