The Train is coming!

Wahlbergin museotalo, Ylinenkatu 11, 23500 Uusikaupunki



The first train arrived in Uusikaupunki on August 2th 1924. The exhibition at the Wahlberg Museum House tells the story of the planning and construction of the hundred-year-old Turku-Uusikaupunki railway, including information about trains and locomotives, as well as the impact of the railway on people's everyday lives, other forms of transportation, trade, and industry.

Naval Pilot Museum

Mäyhälänkatu 2B, Uusikaupunki

Opening hours daily 12 – 3 pm. Free entrance during opening hours. The former Uusikaupunki pilot station on the Vallimäki park has been a small summer museum on the profession of pilots this summer for 50 years. The two-room building displays the original equipment of the pilot station and information on the demanding profession of the pilot.





Sailor's Home Museum Myllykatu 20, Uusikaupunki

Opening hours daily 12 – 3 pm. Free entrance during opening hours. The Seamen's Home Museum is located on the edge of Myllymäki in a building that is one of the oldest preserved residential buildings in Uusikaupunki. The house has been built in the 1770s. The small house is decorated to depict the home of a New Town sailor family from the early 20th century.

Uusikaupunki Automobile Museum Autotehtaankatu 11, Uusikaupunki Opening hours: daily 10am - 6pm

There are more than 100 vehicles in three large exhibition halls, including the largest Saab collection in the world, old motorbikes and mopeds as well as two airplanes and a garage museum. Tickets: Adults EUR 12, children EUR 6.

Bonk-museum

Step into the wild and fantastic world of Bonk! The museum houses things such as de-functioned machinery, cosmic therapy solutions, disinformation systems, and localized black holes. The museum houses a collection of carefully restored Bonk devices and products from mid-1800s to the 1950s. Bonk is a fun fantasy product based on an idea by artist Alvar Gullichsen. The outbuilding houses a children's workshop, Innovatorium, where the more age-challenged members of the family can design and build their own Bonk machines.

Uusikaupunki Maritime centre

The theme of the summer 2024 exhibition is "From sailor to Captain". The exhibition showcases the journey and stages of a young sailor's path to becoming a ship's captain. Free admission to the exhibition.



Uusikaupunki Old Church

Alinenkatu 44, Uusikaupunki.

The grey granite church with a vaulted ceiling was built in 1629, making it the oldest building in the town center. By the church there are an ancient graveyard and soldiers' graves.

Uusikaupunki New Church

Rauhankatu 3, Uusikaupunki.

A Gothic style red-tiled church designed by architect Georg Theodor von Chiewitz. Built between 1858-1863. Short organ recital on Thursdays at noon. 27.6. Virpi Vähäpassi is performing.

Pyhämaa New Church

Kirkontaustantie 15, Pyhämaa. Grey granite church dating from 1804, located next to the Pyhämaa Old Church. Altarpiece by Arvid Liljelund. **Opening hours: Wed–Sat 11am -5pm, Sun 12-4pm. Open till 4.8.** Other times by agreement.

Pyhämaa Old Church ("Uhrikirkko")

Kirkontaustantie 15, in the Pyhämaa village.

Unique wooden church from the early 17th century. The ceiling and interior walls are completely covered with frescoes.

St. Olaf's Church in Kalanti

Pyhän Olavin tie 6, in the Kalanti village.
A grey granite church built in the late 14th century.
Opening hours: Wed-Sat 11am -5pm, Sun 12-4pm. Open till 4.8.
Other times by agreement.

Cultural History Walk -brochure

The Tourist Office provides a brochure on the Cultural History Walk, which allows you to explore on your own the history and sights of the city. The cultural walk is a four-kilometer-long historic walking trail along which most of the downtown tourist attractions are located. The brochure shows a map and a short description of 33 different sights.

Paper maps are available at Tourist office/Passari.



Go outside and explore Uusikaupunki - Find the hidden statues! Hidden Play is a series of small bronze sculptures hidden in the terrain that can be searched for using a digital or printed map. Each route comes with a mobile game that helps you look at the environment from different angles and learn new things. The search is free of charge for the participants. Hidden Play is a combination of community art and treasure hunting games (eg geocaching). Young people have made statues at workshops, brainstormed, and planned a route.

The route is suitable for everyone: residents, school classes, seniors, work groups, travelers, etc. The route runs on both sides of the bay and is about 4-5 km long. You can search for hidden play sculptures at: <u>https://www.piiloleikki.fi/</u>

Velhovesi ring route



Cycling routes in the northern archipelago in Uusikaupunki. The main route is 50 kilometres long. Accommodation, food services, scenic resting places with stories of local history, as well as beaches and direct sale available.

You can rent bikes (also e-bikes) at Tourist Information Office, Rauhankatu 10 and

Santtioranta Camping, Kalalokkukuja 14 hires bikes and e-bikes, too.

Hiunjärvi nature trail



Hiunjärvi is a lake located just north of the Uusikaupunki town centre. Despite its proximity to the centre, the area has remained relatively sparsely populated. The lake is around 12 hectares, and around a third of its surface area is covered by thick vegetation. Hiunjärvi is a popular spot for birdwatching. There is also a nature trail around the lake. Along the trail you can find a lean-to and a bird watching tower. You can

access the trail near the pedestrian underpass by the Saarnisto school or at the end of **Puolukkatie** or **Otavakuja**. The distance from the underpass to the lean-to is about 1 km. The longest route around the trail from the underpass is 3.8 km, and a shorter one is 3.2 km. The distance from the Juolukkatie entrance to the lean-to is 0.7 km. The longest route around the trail from Puolukkatie is 3.6 km, and a shorter one is 1.4 km. From Otavakuja, the shortest route to the lean-to is 1.4 km. The trail is marked using orange diamond symbols as well as by maps located at the starting points and at crossroads.

Kasarminlahti accessible nature trail and birdwatching point

Kasarminlahdentie 8, Uusikaupunki (entrance to accessible trail), with larger parking area.

Accessible birdwatching point and nature trail offer the opportunity to enjoy the forest and get near the water safely. The Kasarminlahti area has a lot of different bird species, and many migratory birds also stop there. Kasarminlahti is located less than two kilometres from the market square. The accessible nature trail and birdwatching platform provide an excellent view over the Kasarminlahti bay and meadow. Services on the accessible section: birdwatching platform, nature trail, accessible composting



outhouse, and benches. In addition to the accessible trail to the birdwatching platform, there is a more demanding trail (not accessible) to the Kasarminlahti lean-to and the Vionpuhti campfire spot. The trail is hilly and part of it is on rocky terrain.



Pamprinniemi nature trail Hauintie 259, Pyhämaa.

The Pamprinniemi nature trail is located in Ketteli in Pyhämaa on church-owned land. The trail is about 4 kilometres long. The area is a significant nature and bird conservation area, as it has been maintained in its natural state. It is part of the European Natura 2000 network. Along the trail, you can experience many kinds of natural surroundings from the seaside to old

spruce forests and patches of fern. You can also spot some very big and old pine trees in the area. Along the trail, you and find a wide range of different bird species. The church has also erected some Bible-themed story boards around the trail. There is a large wooden cross at the tip of the peninsula where the church usually holds an opening ceremony for the trail in early June. The road leading to the trail, Hauintie, is a private road. The trail is open year-round, weather conditions permitting.

Lean-tos



The City of Uusikaupunki has built three leantos in different parts of the town. They can be found in **Hiu, Kasarminlahti, and Oinassaari**. Vakka-Suomen Latu outdoor association has also built a campfire spot in Vionpuhti, near Kasarminlahti.

Sauna at Metsälehto

Haimiontie 365, Uusikaupunki

Summer swimming on Tuesdays from 6 pm to 8 pm. The sauna is located on the shore of a freshwater pool in Haimio. The sauna is spacious and gives good baths! The walkway is partially protected with melting mats and mats to prevent slippage. You should bring a small towel under your feet in the changing room, swimming slippers or socks and a beanie or other headgear. In the sauna, it is important to drink fluids, so also bring something to



drink. There is a barbecue area on the beach, and there is a barbecue hut in the yard. Summer swimming evenings are open to everyone.

Sauna fees in the summer season: €3/person and €1/children under 12 years old.

The Tourist Information Office
